5. Copy of secondary school certificate
6. Copy of degree certificate
7. Proof of at least 6 months of practical experience in the film industry and at least 4 weeks experience on set (placements etc.)
8. Proof of good English skills (e.g. TOEFL, Cambridge Certificate, (study) time abroad) and/or good German skills for English-speaking candidates
9. Copy of identity card or travel document (passport)
10. Optional: a file (or link) with two-minute films (extracts, work samples, montages)

2. General information

1. Applicants who are residents of France send their application in French to La Fémis. Applicants who are residents of Germany, as well as international applicants, submit their application in German or English to Filmakademie Baden-Württemberg.
2. Accepted applicants undertake, by their signature under this form, to attend a language course at their own expense before the programme starts, if their German/French language skills are classed as insufficient.
3. The course fees amount to €1,500, plus pro rata costs for accommodation of €3,400 (subject to change).
4. Accepted applicants can apply for a scholarship.
5. Please only submit samples of your own work.
6. The interviews with the English-speaking applicants will take place online in June 2026.
